

Carebus Service from Beenham village to Newbury on Fridays

A bus service for Beenham village is provided by an organization named 'Carebus', which is based in Theale. The information below has been taken from the Carebus website, www.carebuscommunitytransport.org, under tab '75 bus club'.

Carebus provides a demand responsive service from Beenham to Newbury every Friday.

If you have registered as a member and you want to travel you must telephone Carebus on 0118 930 4837 and select option 2 to leave your name and pickup point by 18:00 the day before to confirm your request.

If you are not registered and wish to, please leave a message at option 3 and Carebus will call you back.

The pickup points are Stoneyfields bus stop (10:00), The Green, and The Six Bells.

The Newbury set down and pickup is at the back of Camp Hopson's in Parkway from where the bus will return to Beenham at 13:00

A return trip to Newbury on the bus costs £3; bus passes are not accepted on this service. If you are at all inclined to use bus services in the future, please register for this service and try it out. One of the main ways we can ensure that bus services continue to serve the village into the future is to use them.
